What is a Dacrocystogram examination?

This is an x-ray examination of the tear ducts using X-rays and X-ray dye.

How is this examination done?

A very small soft tube is put into the tear ducts. X-ray dye is injected through the tube and X-ray pictures are taken. The tube is then removed.

After your examination?

Your eyes may temporarily feel a little sticky and inflamed.
