The clinic

Our sexual health clinic runs every Wednesday on a booked appointment basis from 12 noon to 7 pm. This can be arranged directly with the centre over the phone or in person.

The clinic is staffed by NHS health care professionals. We are able to offer you private and confidential screening for:

- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhoea
- Syphilis
- HIV
- HEP B
- HEP C



Additionally we offer:

- Post exposure prophylaxis
- Hepatitis B vaccinations
- Sexual health advice
- Risk reduction
- Free condoms, dams & lube

Results are usually available within 7 to 10 working days and can be sent to you via text message.
