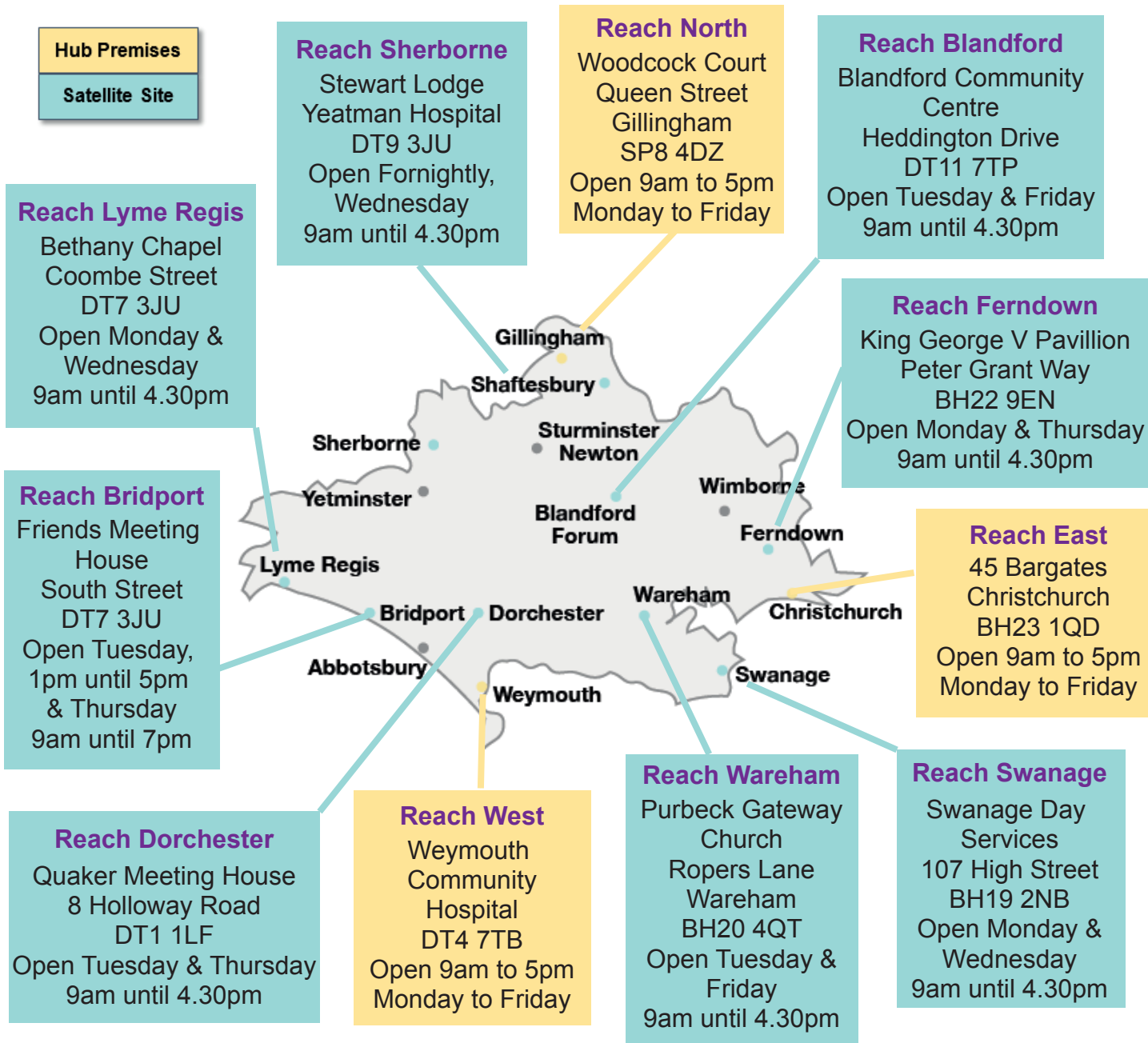

Prescribing

The prescribing intervention is delivered by Avon and Wiltshire Mental Health Trust (AWP) who have extensive experience in delivering this service over a large geographical area.

We are committed to delivering a high quality service and a full range of all prescribing options are available for misuse of opioids, alcohol and other substances.

This includes regimes for:

- Maintenance
- Reduction
- Detoxification
- Relapse Prevention
- Using opioid and non opioid medication in line with NICE and Clinical guidelines

The programme and medication for detoxification, stabilisation or maintenance is agreed by an AWP clinician who will provide regular communication to the registered GP sharing treatment plans including aspects of physical and mental health where appropriate.
