About Lung Health checks

The lung health check programme is a new service offered to those aged 55 to 74 who smoke or have ever smoked.

Why are we offering Lung Health Checks?

Run by specially-trained nurses, lung health checks look at how well your lungs are working. They can help find any problems early, often before people notice anything is wrong. Finding things early also means that treating a problem is often simpler and more successful.

Following a text from your GP you will be sent an appointment letter for a telephone conversation with a health care professional. If appropriate, you will be invited to a face-to-face appointment for your Lung

Health Check. If you do not have a mobile

number registered with your GP, you will be

sent an appointment letter automatically.

3 out of 4 people are diagnosed with lung cancer late due to there often being no signs or symptoms at an early stage.

You will receive a letter in the post for a telephone appointment





During the phone call appointment you will be asked a few questions about your overall health, family and medical history.

If necessary you will be invited for a low dose CT scan of your lungs. Once we have the results, you'll be given the all clear or referred for further investigations.
